



Friends of FDFZ Mid-summer Poker Night Rule Book

*S*chedule

6:00 ~ 6:30pm Registration, Reception and 9-course Dinner Buffet
6:45 ~ Tournament

Tournament starts at 6:45 SHARP. Arrive by 6:30 to allow seating.

*C*ost (cash only)

Dinner \$40 for dinner only attendees
 FREE for tournament players entering before 6:30

Tournament

Buy-in \$100 for 2K T\$ chips (T\$25 x 8, T\$100 x 8, T\$500 x 2)

Re-buy \$100 for 2K T\$ chips up to 8:15pm

Rebuy is only allowed when a player loses all of his chips. Each player can have unlimited number of rebuys on or before the cutoff time.

*P*ayout

50% of total proceeds (net after dinner/venue cost) will be awarded to the top 6 finishers (the other 50% will be donated to the charity). Below is a sample payout table based on \$6000 net proceeds (\$3000 total payout):

*S*eating

Each player draws a table assignment at registration. Players remain at the assigned table until either being eliminated or advance to a different table. Up to 9 players may share a table at the start of the game.

A single player may be moved to a different table to keep headcount balance. The player leaves his old table right before becoming big blind, and is seated at the new table where he will be the next big blind.



The 10 final-tablers enter another drawing for the seating order at the final table.

*B*linds

The schedule for raising blinds is as follows:

Color-up \$25 chips

Player must place all blinds and automatically fold all hands when sitting out.

*B*eginners' tournament

A teach-in session for beginners (with no poker background) will be hosted on a side table starting at 6:45.

A side tournament will be subsequently hosted among the willing beginners. Buy-in amount will be announced at the table.

50% of the proceeds go to the charity; winner takes the remaining 50%.
