每年暑假，复旦附中海外基金会(以下简称:基金会)都会联系在各个领域有独到见解的学长学姐们，为同学们推荐英文书籍，以充实暑假生活。若偶有所得，愿意梳理成文并与我们分享，不如参加英文读后感征文比赛，赢取名次和奖品。

自2014年开始，基金会的荐书传统已经延续了八年。2020年书单是个阶段性的总结，我们在2021年重新出发: 新的思路，适应新的社会发展和话题。那么我们是如何确定这11名终选的呢？

首先，仍然秉承多样化原则，选取各类题材、体裁、写作风格和阅读难度，争取让每一位同学都挑选到适合的书。比如说，光小说类目，就覆盖了经典与流行、情感与思辨、现实与幻想。其次，结合我们收到的反馈，对书页篇幅、语言难度进行限制，以求适用于同学们的认知水平；侧重于大家关心的话题，如传记、社会学、科技；当然，还保留了大家热爱的几本小说，因为它们带来的启迪，已经体现在众多读后感中传达给我们了。最后，如果希望扩展知识的宽度、思想的深度，不妨挑战一下我们预备的妙书。相信即使只是翻阅书单，大家也会享受英语阅读的乐趣，了解海外青年的阅读风潮，说不定能和推荐人有思想的碰撞。

按照惯例，在每一本书的书名下面，我们都标注了类别(Category)，同学们可以选择自己感兴趣的领域进行阅读；首次发行年份(Publishing Year)和页数(Pages)标签，让同学们心中有数。但是，请大家记住，标签并不是绝对的，“兴趣是最好的老师”，读到喜欢的内容，阅读便会变得更顺利。

关于读后感的写作，比起复述书本的(整体或部分)内容，学长学姐们更期待读到你们的所思所想。如果能结合自身经历或者引述事实资料，有条有理、言简意赅地说服我们，那就更棒了。在书单最后，我们还附上了两篇优秀征文，供大家参考、品读。另外，我们提醒同学们注意引用问题: 在引述原文或者他人的观点的时候，一定要注明出处，避免原创性不足的嫌疑。这在国外高校中是常识、是规则、是习惯，可惜在中国的中等教育中还比较少提及。基金会希望通过暑期阅读项目，让附中的同学们得到这种写作训练的机会，和学术理念相接轨。

正因为这些荐书的校友在，我们才能每期都为大家带来新鲜的好书。借此机会，让我们感谢历届荐书者，是他们的引路，让附中学子们跨越学级和大洋、用思想进行对话。大家一起读书，一起思考，无论何时何地，愿良好的阅读习惯伴附中人一路成长。

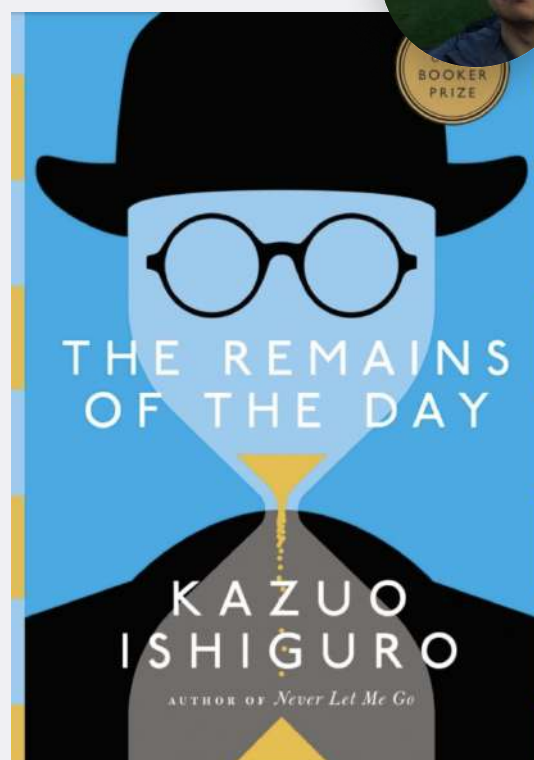

推荐语:

When we dedicate our career to a profession, we (would like to) believe that our efforts will serve a greater good for society. What if this “greater good” is a mere illusion? The novel by the Nobel-winning Kazuo Ishiguro traces the journey of Stevens, the first-rate butler in pre-World War II Britain who believed that by serving his master, Lord Darlington, he serves mankind. As his journey unfolds, however, reality and recollections intertwine and, piece-by-piece, weave the intricate past of Lord Darlington, who sympathized with Nazi Germany during the 1930s and spilled anti-Semitic venom towards his staff. Disillusioned, Stevens is forced to confront the hard reality that his decades of selfless service have not led to the greater good he so firmly believed in. How will he find peace during the remains of the day? Searching for the answer hopefully sheds light on finding meaning in your work and relationships.

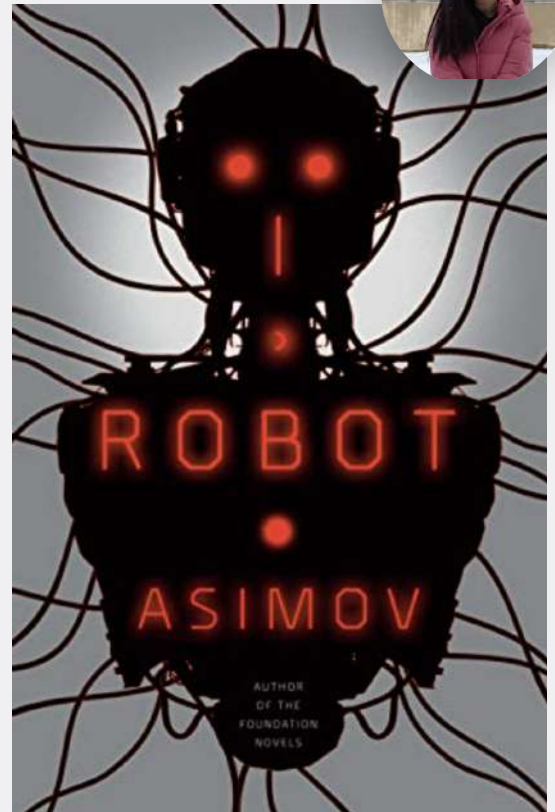

推荐语:

"I, Robot" is a collection of short stories by Isaac Asimov, the only sci-fi writer who has a planetary feature, a Mars crater, and an asteroid named after him. While many authors write separate and independent stories, Asimov is renowned for the astonishingly vast yet consistent universe constructed throughout his writings of different periods. Supporting this universe of books is the rigorous logic grounded in natural and social sciences, as well as his vivid imagination which ingeniously predicts the future of mankind.

Asimov proposes the famous "Three Laws of Robotics" and discusses the relationship of humans and robots had the latter been able to feel and think. The book is important in the history of writings and movies on AI and robots. Each story is relatively easy to read yet full of pleasant surprises. I highly recommend Asimov and this book as a start of the journey.

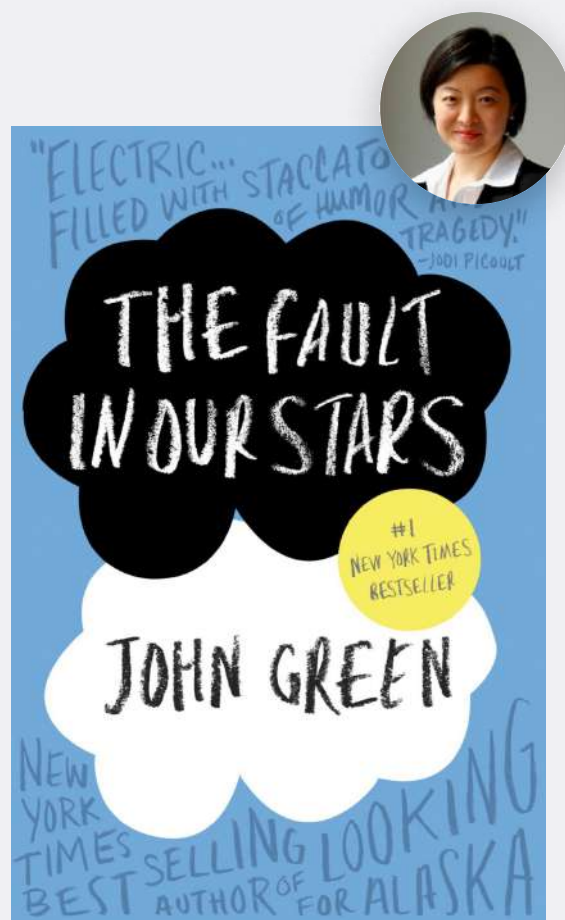

You, with aspiration and anxiety for the future, feel discontent and indignant with the fact “All animals are equal, but some animals are more equal than others” – but aren't you in fact in the advantaged position of being "more equal"?

This book is an easy read, yet a trenchant one. It reminds us of the endeavors yet to be accomplished, which requires generations of effort. The power of youth lies in the unceasing desire to stand up from mires, and the omnipresent hope, to improve upon the plights.

Never worry about your speed of reading. If in reading you find anything puzzling, linger over it, ponder upon it, and try to formulate that puzzle in your own language. If you find anything interesting, read more closely, pay more attention to it, and try harder to reveal its full implications. If you find anything touching, try not to relate that to your own thought and experience too hastily. Those classics, those great books, are worthy to be read once and again, for talented student like you; always open them as if they can always help you learn something new.

The book presents his opinions on various interesting cases and his understandings based on experience with entrepreneurs and startups. Thus it includes many controversial opinions, but the value of reading this book lies within the thinking process and your own reflections on his controversial thoughts. Please note that, due to the time that the book was written and the author's personal background, some ideas presented in the book is limited by chronological and geopolitical constraints, and you may also find discovering such perspective limitations interesting. Overall, it is a great book for those interested in innovations and entrepreneurship.

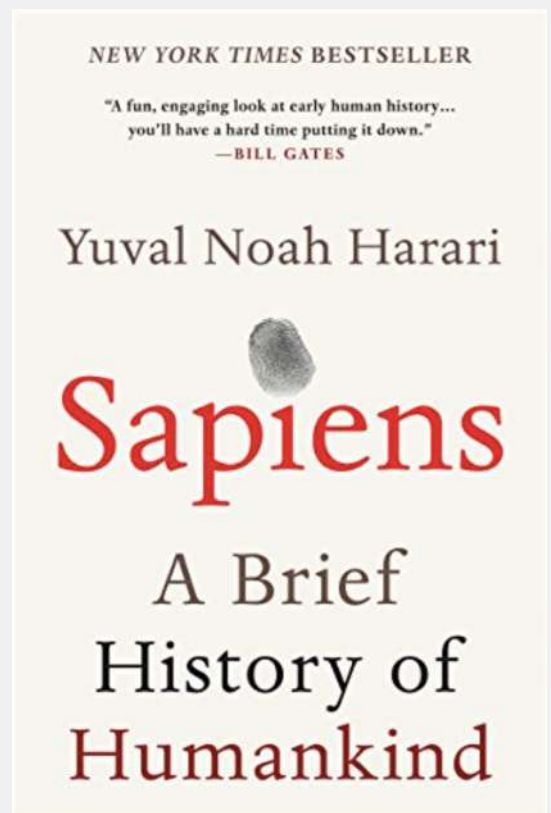

A comprehensive yet entertaining overview of the history of humankind, through the lens of different fields of studies. It offers unique (and controversial) insights on “why” and “how” human development happens.



附录一：如何写好书评？

为了方便没有阅读英文原著或者用英语写读后感经验的同学们，基金会为大家准备了以下小贴士。和任何模版一样，得心应手后就可以按照自己的阅读习惯加以灵活运用。

选择哪一本书？从喜欢的内容入手！

首先，书单上每一页书名下面的分类(Category)，能够帮你了解这本书的题材和体裁。社科、科技、小说等不同类别的文章，往往对应着不同的写作手法、行文风格。我们在历年的读后感文章中，点播率最高的是小说，它的文字因为情节性强而获得了同学们的青睐，但写作背景和修辞手法又会造成一定的阅读障碍。

选择一本题材和你感兴趣的内容相关的书，而不要被书的长度所欺骗。众所周知，《哈利·波特》那么长，但翻起来非常快；而《论语》那么短，读起来却委实不易。一般来说，选择你喜欢的内容会相对不易因为阅读过程中的词汇和语法瓶颈导致读不下去的窘境。进行一个章节的试读，也是帮助你快速做出判断的好方法。

其次，可以调查一下这个作者的背景，他/她是在什么情况下、为什么样的读者写的这本书？这本书是什么年代出版的？做出过什么贡献，又在该分类有什么样的地位？收集这些信息亦有助于帮你判断从什么角度来理解这本书。

另外，如果从推荐这本书的校友的背景入手，也许有意外的线索。看看这是不是你以后兴趣发展的方向；也可以从校友写的推荐入手，看看他们对于这本书的理解，为什么要推荐它呢？如果实在吃不准的话，不要害羞，咨询一下你的老师，他/她会很高兴给你提供建议哦。

如何阅读？不要让生词难句成为你的障碍！

你需要了解“我要读什么”和“我已经读了什么”。翻一下目录，大致了解每一章主题。读的时候记得记笔记和做小结。“记笔记”指的不仅是生词、好词，修辞手法或例子，更包括了你喜欢的语句，作者的论点论据。如果碰上了有疑问的内容，可以做个书签，待读完一个段落，再回头查证。“做小结”则是说每段读完后概括一下段落大意，这样有助于区分有效信息和不必要的细节，更能帮助联系前后文加深理解。如果生词和难句显著地影响了你对于阅读的理解，那么在查阅字典之后再通读一遍也是有帮助的。

我们读外语书的时候，常常会读了一大段却不知所云，甚至畏难而就此搁浅——这很正常。怎么办？找一个(或者一群)小伙伴一起组成读书打卡小组，在通报进度、互相打气之外，还可以读完一章后把意思讲给对方听，看大家是否理解得一致。在海外读大学时，大家一起形成Study Group 来完成作业是常有的事，但最重要的是，大家一起理解了以后，每个人要形成自己的思考。

如何写作?把你的思想表达出来!

多年来，在读后感征文中，我们常常被个别学生的文采和思想所惊异。同时，看到许多同学对写英语写作无从下手，有所思考却困于表达，也非常可惜。因此，给大家提出一些建议：

首先，确定行文的结构。就内容结构而言，书评一般为议论文，这和中文的议论文是比较相似的(参照附图)。但有几大注意事项：一是英文写作中，每篇的首段、每段的首句一般会提纲挈领地概括主旨。对应地，每篇的末端、每段的末句，一般会在概括的基础上进行引申。二是英文写作非常注重学术诚信(Academic Honesty)，即对已有文献的引述。如果你用他人的观点或表述来支持或反驳作者的观点，那你必须要提供脚注或者附注。特别是基于反剽窃(Anti-plagiarism)的考虑，请克制对原文、他人文章、网络资源等的过多借鉴。三是简化你的表达内容，注重词句的准确性。如果采用你所熟悉的语法和词汇来构成语句，包括原书中的常用搭配等(看看你的笔记!)，会比中翻英更能贴近你想表达的意思。

虽然第一次写英文书评不简单，但最重要的是，不要因为你的英文能力还无法表达出你的思想而灰心!不要放弃!要知道并非所有美丽的文字都一定要用复杂的词汇或者句式来表达。如果你翻看下一页的获奖作品选读，你会发现，比起华丽的词藻，我们更期待有思想的灵魂。有时候简单的语句蕴含着不平凡的想法。仔细想一想，理清思路，你一定可以做到的。

最后，通读一遍你的文章，是否有单词或者语法的错误?调整一下格式，修改完以后再看看，你已经做到了!

附录二：优秀征文选读

My Book Review on Animal Farm – 2022 郭辰萱

Animal Farm, one of George Orwell's most influential works, basically posed a general pattern of doomed uprisings in modern history. Through the fable full of implications, Orwell once again gave a sharp satire on political reality.

What's especially unique about this fiction lies in its simplicity. Instead of dealing with complex topics like individual consciousness or the liberty of love, it concentrates on portraying the way a totalitarian regime is established. You can see how the regime corrupted from inside and how the ruling class reinforced the power through incitement to hatred and personality cult. "All animals are equal" was inevitably followed by "but some animals are more equal than others" and in the end, the animals, whose ignorance were taken advantage of, achieved neither freedom nor equality.

Another point worth mentioning is that, unlike other works by Orwell, Animal Farm is fairly less delicate with its words. The typical gloomy atmosphere and precise language are not very prominent in Animal Farm. But the plain language indeed managed to add a sense of absurdity to the whole story, shaping a distinct artistic feature.

Besides the central idea and overall style, some other elements are also intensively discussed. One is the natural care and love among the animals. There are few more distressing but touching sights than that of Clover laying in Boxer's stall and Old Benjamin keeping flies off the over-exhausted stallion. All the misery and suffering didn't wear away the tenderness for each other and it was the selfless caring that reflected the sparkling part of humanity.

Another element, the perpetual pursuit for freedom, never fails to touch me. The animals were always willing to take pains and endure whatever might come, all but for the seemingly abstract ideal of freedom of all. They might get unconfident in themselves at times, but they never came to lose faith in this initial and ultimate goal of freedom. Is this plain ignorance or blindness? Rather, we call this durable motivation what distinguishes human beings. This actually reminded me of Vonnegut's fiction Slaughterhouse No.5, in which the Tralfamadorian told Pilgrim in complete bewilderment, "I've visited thirty-one inhabited planets in the universe, and I have studied reports on one hundred more. Only on Earth is there any talk of free will."

Last but not least, I'd like to express my view of George Orwell, not only as a terrific novelist, but also a respectable figure of all time. For him, it's just impossible to separate the politics from the art. This is not necessarily less or more noble than trying to reduce the influence of political opinions in works of art. What really matters is whether you can feel the genuine love and concern and relate to his profound feelings in every view he tried to convey. Orwell, the wintry conscience of his generation, felt it his duty to cover the enduring topic of how politics, in a broad sense, may affect everyone from every aspect and that's exactly why he deserves the admiration of generations after.

In a nutshell, *Animal Farm* is a thought-provoking satire that is surprisingly easy to read. By trying to look into the plot and characterization, I felt like falling for the literary giant all over again.

附录三：关于“知缘阁”

2006年秋，一个周六的下午，在美国纽约公园大道和五十一街街口的一家“星巴克”里，五位附中校友机缘巧合地坐在了一起。虽然大家毕业年份不同，从1984届到2000届，但大家的共同点，附中留下的那份传统，一种校友文化，一份人文关怀，却把大家聚到了一起。经过一番激烈的讨论之后，复旦附中海外基金会就这么诞生了。从诞辰至今，历经十三年，基金会一直都致力于为附中带来更多教育资源，关注附中学子社会责任和人文精神的养成。

经历了美国的大学教育，回忆起过去附中的学习生活，在海外求学或者工作的附中校友们往往会感叹，与大学相比，在高中时的阅读量小很多，尤其是在英语方面。即使是中国最优秀的高中，英语的阅读资源毕竟还是不够充裕，学生也较难养成良好的阅读习惯。然而，书却恰恰是人文精神最好的载体，传承人类五千年来的文化，静静叙述着古往今来，议论着天下时事，为读者开启一扇窗，惊鸿一瞥那灿烂的文明。而英文的资源，由于写作思考方式的不同，往往也会为中国读者提供一个全新视角，令人耳目一新。

顺着这样的思路，基金会于2009年开始动员附中海外校友资源，在附中创建学生资源中心——“知缘阁”。附中校友志愿者们通过直接进口的方式将海外的书籍资料引入附中，将这部分资源公开放置在“知缘阁”。在每年编纂进口书目的时候，我们校友志愿者们也力求书籍种类的多样性，涵盖各个学科领域最浅显易懂的经典著作，保证附中的同学们在读过每本书后，都有一份收获与成长。
